

Dr. Amie Franklin Chairman and CEO

Dr. Franklin is the founder, CEO and Chairman of OxyBand Technologies, Inc. Since 2003, she has led the company from a concept to the company's first commercially available FDA cleared medical device, OxyBand Wound DressingTM. OxyBand Wound DressingTM looks and feels like a

traditional wound dressing and acts similar to a transdermal patch providing pure oxygen gas to wounds for up to 5 days. Several civilian and one military clinical trial have been conducted on the efficacy of OxyBand Wound DressingTM, including at the US Army's Institute for Surgical Research ("USAISR"). The USAISR is one of the most prestigious surgical institutes in the world; it is a Center of Excellence for Battlefield Health, Trauma and Burn Research and Clinical Care.

The results of the USAISR study show OxyBand Wound DressingTM heals wounds significantly faster with significantly less pain and a reduced risk of infection compared to standard of care. The results of the USAISR clinical trial were recently presented by the USAISR, and the abstract has been published by the USASR. Dr. Franklin has been responsible for OxyBand's business and growth from formation, financing, research and development, patenting, clinical trials, FDA, government contracts, corporate partnerships, joint ventures, manufacturing, distribution and sales.

Dr. Franklin has been the inspiration and force behind OxyBand, and she sets corporate policy with the board of directors for the company. Dr. Franklin has negotiated and delivered partnerships with 3M Manufacturing, McKesson Distribution, and Lighthouse for the Blind (manufacturing) for the Company's first commercial line of medical devices. OxyBand Wound DressingTM that has received a prime vendor contract, DAPA, with the US Federal Government.

Dr. Franklin was the Principal Investigator and Author of the US Department of Defense \$1.5 million dollar Army Grant and she has been the author on posters and patents for OxyBand. Dr. Franklin is considered an expert on the subject of oxygen for wound and tissue healing.

Dr. Franklin served as President of DrugEmporium.Com, the principal operating subsidiary of Drug Emporium, a public traded company, with 5,000 employees and \$1.5 billion in annual revenue. Dr. Franklin held positions of responsibility in both science and business at MotherNature.com, which went public in 1999.

Dr. Franklin is a distinguished lecturer and public speaker. She has presented at the Army Tactical Advanced Combat Casualty Care Conference, Society for Advanced Wound Care Conference, American Arthritis Foundation, Society for Fitness in Business among other professional conferences. She has several published, US and International Patents. She has been written about in the Wall Street Journal and popular magazines such as "Allure".
